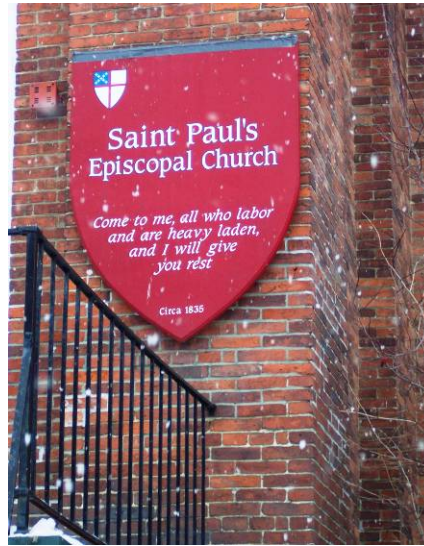


Our Community
