#### ANNUAL MEETING HELD

Due to inclement weather, The Annual Meeting of the Parish was held on its "snow date" of Sunday, January 27. Annual Reports for 2018 and the budget for fiscal year 2019 were received.

In the elections that took place, Bo Price and David Merrill were made members of the Vestry Class of 2022. In a variation from regular practice, this year's Convention Delegates were chosen to attend both the Diocesan Convention in October and the Convention to Elect a Bishop in May. Those elected as Delegates were Cricket Laidman, Tim Earle, and Bo Price. Elected as Alternates to the conventions were Mary Gordon, Sarah Mangini, and Sarah Cowan.

In further business, Bo Price and Sarah Cowan offered a report from the Stewardship Committee. Next the Rector spoke of his plans to retire from St. Paul's in July after having served here for 10 plus years. As Treasurer, John Stroup led the assembly through the budget for 2019. Finally, representing the Strategic Investment for Sacred Places Committee, Sarah Stroup offered information on the grants that have received for restoring the stained glass windows. She also spoke about future landscaping plans to make the church's grounds more hospitable. The meeting concluded with the Litany of Thanksgiving.

As required, immediately following the Annual Meeting, the newly-elected Vestry gathered. At this brief meeting, Sarah Cowan was appointed as Senior Warden, and Chris Hale was elected as Junior Warden.
