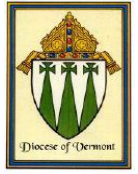


St. Paul's Epistle

What does Governor Scott's recent announcement about reopening places of worship mean for us?

As many of you may know, the Governor has announced churches and other places of worship may reopen under specific conditions. What does this mean for us?

Several weeks ago, Bishop Shannon appointed the Diocesan Re-Start committee. They are working to provide protocols for a safer path forward. These protocols are based on VT Dept of Health guidelines and CDC requirements.

St. Paul's vestry is up to date with the latest information from Bishop Shannon and the Restart Committee. As required by the State of Vermont and our Bishop, vestry members and staff are in the process of completing the VOSHA (Vermont Occupational Safety and Health Administration) online training in methods of protection from COVID-19 virus in the workplace.

Lastly, we need your help. Laurie Earle has already volunteered. We need 2-3 more of you to become St. Paul's re-start ministry team. In anticipation of the diocesan re-opening safely protocols, we want to begin to imagine what it might look like for us over the coming weeks and months. No doubt we will move slowly, methodically and in phases. The health and safety of us all and our neighbors is our Christian call and priority.

Please contact Sherry or Rebecca if you are willing to serve. We will also gather to offer a congregational wide Zoom event (and calls to those not on Zoom) for Q&A and conversation.

Get-to-Know-You Walks & Visits Begin Again!

With the Vestry's support, Sherry will once again offer a time to get to know one another. With some changes.

1. You must contact me and express a desire to meet
2. We can walk. No more than a total of 3 people from different families
3. We can sit in lawn chairs outside either at your home or the rectory. 3-4 total
4. Face coverings are mandatory unless you are unable to do so safely
5. Physical distancing of 6 feet or more will be followed
6. For those living at a distance, we can Zoom, FaceTime or, hold onto your hat, talk on the telephone!

Below is a brief secretary/clerk job description:

Time commitment

- Distribution of agenda and minutes from previous meetings
- Maintain roster of members and contact information
- Other duties as deemed necessary by the rector and senior warden

Responsibilities

- Take notes during vestry meetings and afterwards prepare and distribute minutes
- Maintain a file of all vestry meeting minutes
- If asked, take minutes for the annual congregation meeting
- Prepare, date, sign, and maintain documents as required

Accountability

- The secretary/clerk may be elected or appointed as provided for by diocesan or congregational bylaws.
- The secretary/clerk is accountable to the rector and vestry.
- A covenant between the secretary/clerk, rector, and the vestry should be developed and reviewed annually.
- The secretary's/clerk's ministry should be considered a part of the annual mutual ministry review.

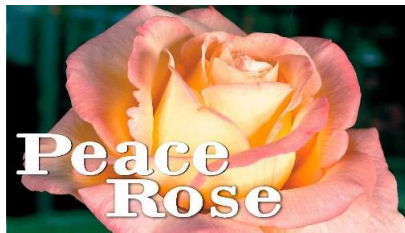
