Vergennes MMR October 13, 2018

Four Goals Emerged:

1. Develop a sustainable Financial Plan - Target Date. October 2019

- a. Analyze spending to pare down budget for development of 2019 budget
- b. Reduce size of deficit budget annually and eliminate over 3-5-year period
- c. Develop policy for use/investment/encouragement of testamentary gifts
- d. Develop sustainable plan for building ownership/use
- e. Increase cash flow through grants and/or selling buildings
- f. Decrease spending: 80%-time priest; alternative use of rectory

By Jan. 1 John will develop some charts and graphs to assist with budget development for 2019

Those active with SISP will continue and deepen their work and make recommendations to the vestry about building use including the rectory.
