Eleventh Bishop of Vermont Elected

At St. Paul's Cathedral on May 18 a convention was held to elect a new bishop for the diocese. Attending as delegates from St. Paul's were Tim Earle, Alan Kittelson, Cricket Laidman and Bo Price. Sarah Cowan attended as an observer and ballot clerk.

Eucharist was celebrated at 10 o'clock and followed by a voting session. On the first ballot, The Rev. Dr. Shannon McVean-Brown was elected. She is currently rector of St. Thomas, Franklin, Indiana. and now will be moving to Vermont.

The consecration of the new bishop is scheduled for Saturday, September 28, at the Ira Allen Chapel in Burlington.

Priest Transition

The Vestry met with Cannon Lynn Bates and Bishop Ely at their April Vestry meeting in order to begin the discussion about Fr. Alan's retirement and our transition. They shared very good information about the process and the Vestry agreed to begin regular discussions with Cannon Bates over the next several months. Treasurer, John Stroup, Vestry member Nan Guilmette and Sr. Warden Sarah Cowan will begin with phone conferences to further review and discuss next steps. Cannon Bates encouraged the Vestry to create a small committee that will act as the transition committee for the parish.
